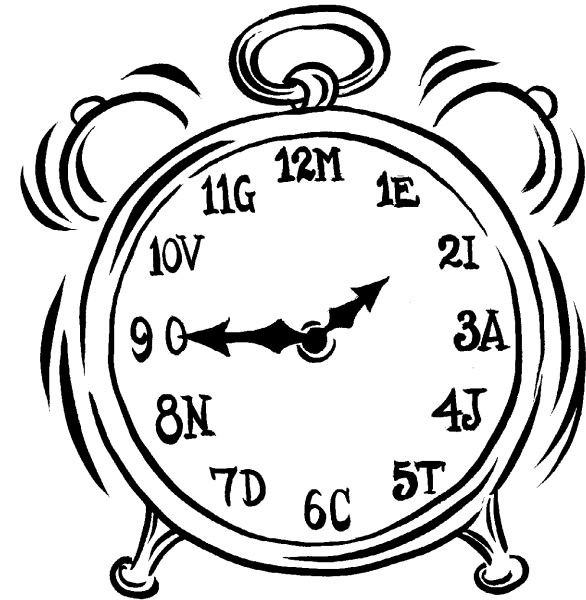
First Sunday of Advent
