Annual Meeting to be held January 26th at noon.

Reports and nominees for committee members are due by December 19th.

Covers for annual report have been ordered from Augsburg.

Becky, Darrell, Sue, and Christine attended conference for leaders, bringing back ideas as to how to be more hospitable at church and for outreach.

Reports:

Evangelism: Looking to set up core groups to welcome people and offer info about the church. Also, planning to teach ushers and greeters how to be more hospitable.

Communications & Tech: Noted that events need to be done to the "hilt". Save the date, advertise, send teasers, and collect info. in order to be more intentional. Each event should look different than the year before. Planning should be directed to a target audience. Please have any info for the following church service in by the Wednesday before.

Treasurer's Report: Total deposits through Oct. 31, 2019 were \$297,809.81. Expenses for the same period were \$302,514.54. Checking account balance at the end of October was \$16.91. Payroll taxes and benevolences are up to date. We had to borrow \$4,000 from the Berg Fund.

Pastor Siri: Report submitted. Confirmation for 2 girls, funeral for Dale Long, and planning for Daren's funeral. (Stephanie noted that it was Daren's hope that there would be a West entrance made for Grace Lutheran). Took a vacation to be with dad, who has a reoccurring cancer.

Worship: Rally Day included 100 people. Poinsettias for Christmas have been ordered with the Advent tree going up November 30th. Sign ups for volunteers have been going well. Motion was made to combine Bells and Candle light services at 5pm for Christmas. Motion approved.

Stewardship: Cookie Jar serving for Stewardship Sunday, with "Let's Bake" providing dessert.

Women of Grace: Soup and Pie had 447 in attendance with \$4,700 taken in. Donations have been made to the Banquet, LWR, and Youth, as well as Trunk and Treat. The WOG Christmas Luncheon will be Dec. 7th @ 11:30. The theme is "Mangers" including a harpist for the program. Tony's is catering, \$8.00 a person.

Music Ministry: Pastor Siri reported that the music for Advent is covered. Plans are being set for the Cantata and for Lent. **Faith & Family:** Attended October Conference. Trunk and Treat was a success. Grace Kids has had an attendance of 17 children. Lisa has taken a long-term sub assignment at the Lutheran School.

Parish Nurse: Report submitted and working with a new computer. A Thrivent Card has been used for cookies and for personal care kits.

Youth and Young Adult: Written Report submitted. WiFi connecting point has been installed for all of the downstairs. Dinner theater work has begun as well as work with the Christmas Program.

Church & Society: 12,000 rolls of TP as been donated and distributed. The mitten tree has been set up for hats and mittens to be given to Ideal, as well as Cleveland Elem. A library box has been built by Don Schmidt to share books with the community. **Property Committee:** Written Report submitted. Thanks to all who helped with Fall Cleanup!


