## Coming to church

- F If you, or any member of your immediate family, do not feel well or have any of the following symptoms please stay home:
  - Fever of 100.4 or higher;
  - Cough, chills, body aches, or sore throat;
  - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing;
  - Recent loss of taste or smell.
- Outside doors will be propped open as weather allows and ushers will hold open doors or operate door openers for people as they enter.
- Hand sanitizers will be available in the narthex and in the sanctuary.
- Every other pew will be blocked off and each group should practice 6' social distancing.
- Please respect the 6' distance throughout the church, especially when entering and exiting.
- Face masks are not required but you are encouraged to wear one.

- There will not be handshakes during the passing of the peace.
